**REPORT OF TEACHER ORIENTATION PROGRAMMES**

**THREE DAY NATIONAL LEVEL RESIDENTIAL WORKSHOP ON TEACHER EDUCATION -COMPILATION OF PROPOSALS FOR NEP 2020 BASED CURRICULUM**

The Three-day National Level Residential Workshop on Teacher Education- Compilation of Proposals for NEP 2020 Based Curriculum, jointly organized by Vidyabhyasa Vikasa Kendram Kerala, National Institute of Open Schooling and Sree Narayana Training College Nedunganda was conducted at Sivagiri convention centre from 07.05.2022 to 09.05.2022. The workshop was organised in order to prepare guidelines for the structure of teacher education curriculum in the light of National Education Policy 2020. Head of the Institutions and representatives of teacher education institutions from various universities of Kerala were the major participants.

On 7 May 2022, debriefing session was conducted among the participants. On 8 May 2022, the inaugural ceremony of the workshop started at 10:00 a.m. Sreemad Sachchidananda Swamikal, the president of Sree Narayana Dharma Sangam Sivagiri, had done deepa prajwainam for the inaugural session and Ms. Aparna Raj, student of Sree Narayana Training College recited Daivadasakam, the universal prayer written by Sree Narayana Guru to seek blessings from the God. Prof. (Dr.) M. V. Natesan, the former HOD, Department of Vyakarana, Sree Sankara Sanskrit University welcomed the gathering. Prof. (Dr.) M. Abdul Salam, former Vice Chancellor of University of Calicut give the presidential address and the inauguration of the workshop was done by Prof. (Dr.) Panchanatham, the Vice Chancellor of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University. He spoke about the need for changes in the teacher education curriculum for the new era. Prof. (Dr.) Saroj Sharma the chairperson of National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) delivered the keynote address by focusing the need for integrating the multidimensional aspects in the teacher education curriculum. The keynote address was followed by introductory talk on Integrated Teacher Education Programme by guest of honour, Prof. (Dr.) K.K. Shine, Chairman of NCTE, southern region. The benedictory address was given by Sreemad Sachchidananda Swamikal. Dr. Manoj Kumar Takur, the Regional Director in-charge of National Institute of Open Schooling, Kochi and Sree A. Vinod, member of the monitoring committee of Education Government of India had felicitated the inaugural session. The inaugural session was blessed by the gracious presence of Dr. N. C. Induchoodan, former DFO and President of Vidhyabhyasa Vikasa Kendram, Kerala. Dr. Sheeba P., Principal of Sree Narayana Training College Nedunganda, delivered the formal vote of thanks for the session.

The second session of the workshop started at 12 p.m. Sreemad Rthambharananda Swamikal, the secretary of Sree Narayana Dharma Sangham, Sivagiri delivered a talk on educational perspective of Sree Narayana Guru. He talked about Sree Narayana philosophy in the context of education and its significance in the present scenario. Afternoon session started at 2 p.m. by Prof. (Dr.) Saroj Sharma and she briefed National Education Policy with special reference to Integrated Teacher Education Programme.

The technical sessions of the workshop started at 2:00 p.m. and there were two groups and were organized as parallel sessions. Group 1 discussed about the philosophical and sociological foundations of education and Group 2 discussed about the pedagogical foundation of education. At 6 p.m., a field trip to Papanasam beach was arranged for the delegates and everybody enjoyed the same.

On 9th May, after the breakfast a spiritual talk was organized for the participants at Sivagiri and Swami Guruprasad delivered the value oriented speech. It was followed by the technical sessions on Integrated Teacher Education programme at the convention Centre and there was group discussion, and the group discussions was led by Prof (Dr.) Chand Kiran Saluja, former Prof. Dept of Education, Delhi University and All India President, Samskrit Bharati. The prepared materials were presented by Dr. Malini P.M., former Principal of NSS Training College, Pandalam.

The major suggestions concluded from the workshop were as follows.

- Pedagogy must be started from first semester onwards.
- Internship must be started from fifth semester and spread over all other semesters. Teaching practice in last two semesters.
- Peer teaching, criticism, presentation of model lesson plans in college.
- Students should teach at different levels in his own subject.
- Teachers should be taught how to handle differently abled students.
- Theory must be integrated with practicum and practical.
- Work with Community and Peer teaching is must.
- Inclusive education must be included in pedagogy and practical sessions.
- Students must be made familiar with fundamental duties through various cultural programmes.
- Blogging and digital portfolio should be used.
- Innovative teaching and self-evaluation.
- Improve soft skills (all round skill development).
- Student teachers should be conceptually clear about pedagogy and methodology of teaching.

The Valedictory function of the three-day national workshop started at 2:00 p.m. The function started with the prayer by Aparna Raj and Sri. P. P. Rajesh, state coordinator of Teacher Education, Vidyabhyasa Vikasa kendram Kerala welcomed to the audience. The presidential address was given by Dr. N.C. Induchoodan, former DFO and President of Vidyabhyasa Vikasa Kendra. The function was inaugurated by Dr. P.M. Mubarak Pasha, Vice Chancellor of Sree Narayana Guru Open University. The guest of honour Panditaratna Prof. (Dr.) P. K. Madhavan, Former Principal Government College Chalakudy and former member NCTE and former President of Vidya Bharati talked about the need for the integration of indigenous knowledge in the Teacher Education curriculum. It was followed by message of Shri. Joby Baiakrishnan, member NCTE and Sri. B. K Priyesh Kumar, state secretary, Vidyabhyasa vikasa kendram Kerala. Prof. (Dr.) K. K. Shine, chairman of NCTE Southern region, pointed out the need for inculcating and integrating Indian culture and knowledge along with the teacher education. Sri. Aji S.R.M. executive member SN Trusts, Kollam proposed vote of thanks for the session and the programme came to an end by the national anthem.

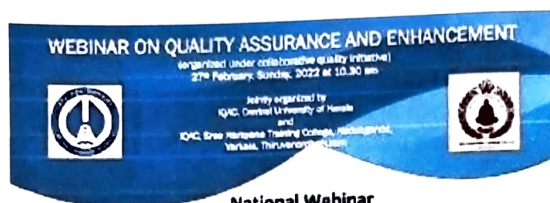

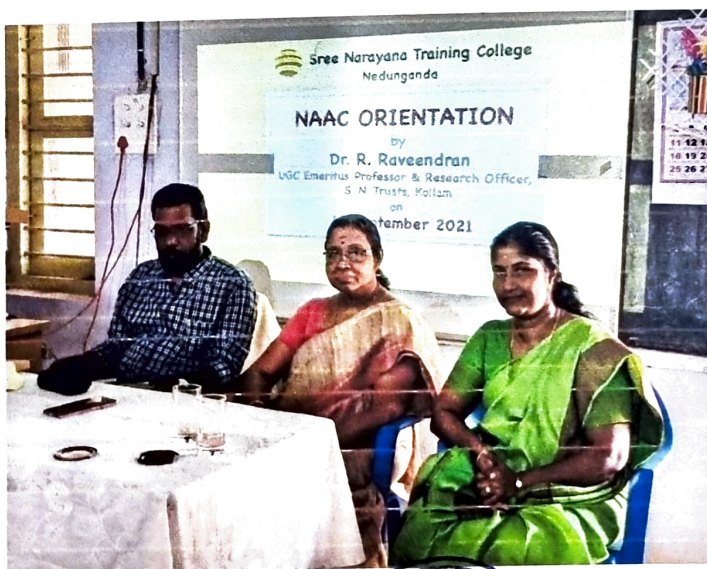

**WEB CONFERENCE SERIES ON 'ADDRESSING WAYS OF  
IMPLEMENTATION OF B.Ed. CURRICULUM IN THE COVID-19  
PANDEMIC SCENARIO'**

**Report of Phase 1 Focus Group Web Conference on 17.06.2020**

The first phase of the web conference series on 'Addressing Ways of Implementation of B.Ed. Curriculum in the covid-19 Pandemic Scenario' organised by Sree Narayana Training College, Nedunganda in collaboration with Board of Studies (Pass) in Education, University of Kerala and Kerala University English Teacher Educators Forum (KUETEF) was conducted on 17.06.2020 from 10:00 a.m. to 1.00 pm on Google Meet.

The first phase of the conference was Focus Group video conference attended by the members of Board of Studies (Pass) in Education, University of Kerala and Principals of Training colleges and Teacher Education Centers affiliated to the University of Kerala. The program started with the prayer. Dr. Sheeba P., Principal Sree Narayana Training College, Varkala delivered the Welcome speech. Dr. Geetha Janet Vitus, Chairman Board of Studies (PASS) in Education, University of Kerala delivered the Presidential address. She stressed the immediate need for resolving the problems faced by the teacher educators in the present pandemic scenario. The Chairman also focused on the conditions of technological competency of Teacher Educators and the prospective teachers with special reference to the curriculum transaction in the scenario.

The presidential address was followed by Inauguration of the Web-Conference Series by the Chief Guest, Dr. Rajan Varghese, Member Secretary, Kerala State Higher Education Council. The Honorable Chief guest addressed the situation in a multifaceted level. Along with the economic challenges going to be faced by the country in the present condition, he also stressed on various challenges to be faced at the institutional and individual level in the higher education system. He also pointed out the deficiencies in the infrastructural facilities including the extent of internet penetration in the country. He emphasized the necessity for smart classrooms, smart teachers and the need for developing training sessions for faculty of higher education. He also mentioned that the Higher Education Council is planning to develop a platform for e-content development. With special reference to the teacher education system, he emphasized the need for enhancing the quality of prospective teachers in the present pandemic situation. He concluded the inaugural address by focusing on the suggestions of University Grant Commission (UGC) which emphasize the interest of students to be kept in mind during the situation.

The Inaugural session was followed by the Keynote by Dr. Bindu R.L., HOD and Dean, Faculty of Education, University of Kerala. She focused on the need for addressing the practical aspects of the B.Ed. curriculum in the situation. She suggested certain possible solutions that can be adopted to deal with the situation including script writing for online classes, learning experiences,

evaluation techniques, modification in the curriculum and internship and need for training teacher educators in the present scenario. She wished that the webinar series may come out with fruitful suggestions for the smooth implementation of the B.Ed. course in the challenging situation.

The keynote address was followed by a presentation of an overview of the B.Ed. curriculum with special reference to semester III which need immediate attention in the present challenging situation. Dr. Sheeba P., Principal SN Training College Nedunganda had presented the overview. The presentation also covered semesters I, II and IV with particular emphasis to practical works and examination. The presentation was followed by special remarks of Dr. Giby Geevarughese, Former Chairman, BOS (PASS) in Education, University of Kerala and Faculty Mar Theophilus Training College, Nalanchira followed. She stressed that while compromising the curriculum, the students should not suffer, and the curriculum adaptation should consider the interest of the students. She also stressed on the challenges faced by the teacher educators, student teachers, parents and the institution in the present pandemic condition.

### ***Suggestions made in the Open Forum***

The next session discussed the measures to be adopted in the curriculum in order to deal with the pandemic situation. The following suggestions were derived from the deliberations made by veteran academicians.

- The number of lessons for practice teaching can be minimised to 20 or 30 and student teachers to be trained through online teaching. Practice Teaching can be made after the Onam holidays. Duration of Practice teaching session can be minimised. Out of the 40 lessons, 10 lessons can be converted into link lessons, 20 lessons can be given for direct practice teaching period and the remaining 10 lessons can be integrated with that of semester IV.
- Practical Examination of semester III to be shifted to semester IV.
- EDU 11 in the Semester III in terms of the content should be minimised.
- Curriculum localisation can be adopted.
- Review of classes on Victors channel can be assigned to student teachers.
- Yoga and Health Education can be practiced during the period and can be uploaded by the student teachers in their blog.
- The academic calendar should be modified and restructured. The disparity in the attendance and working days in the semester III should be reconsidered.
- Class work and project work can be given on online platform.
- The duration of community living camp can be limited to three days and if possible, it can be organised in the month of December.
- Viva voce can be conducted on online mode.
- To avoid mass failure in the online examination, the questions can be selected from the bank prepared by the University.
- Practical Examination at two phases can be integrated during the pandemic condition.
- Online mode should be considered as a temporary arrangement. Community survey can be organized instead of field trips. Virtual tour can be adopted. Measures should be adopted for avoiding course lag.

- Lack of infrastructure and internet facilities of students should be taken into account.
- Semester III examinations can be postponed by taking into consideration the transportation difficulties of students from other districts including Hotspots. More sub-centres can be allotted.

After considering the suggestions by the principals from various Teacher Education Institutions, the Chairman of Board of Studies in Education, University of Kerala concluded Phase I by giving the following remarks:

- The student teachers must write 40 practice teaching lessons to get theoretical practice out of which, 10 lessons can be tried out on online mode.
- There are practical difficulties in the curriculum localization.
- Practical examinations of Semester III can be shifted to Semester IV.
- Difficulties in Semester II examination may be brought to the attention of the concerned authorities.

The Chairman concluded the Web Series (Phase I) by inviting Subject Conveners' suggestions for the next phase of the web conference. The Phase I came to an end by vote of thanks by one of the coordinators, Dr. Velayudhan Nair T., Member, KUETEF & Assistant Professor, Peet Memorial Training College, Mavelikara. Dr. Reetha Ravi H., Assistant Professor, Sree Narayana Training College & member, KUETEF and Sri. E. K. Jijan, Secretary, KUETEF & Assistant Professor Mount Tabor Training College were the other two Coordinators of the Web conference who were actively involved in the web meeting.

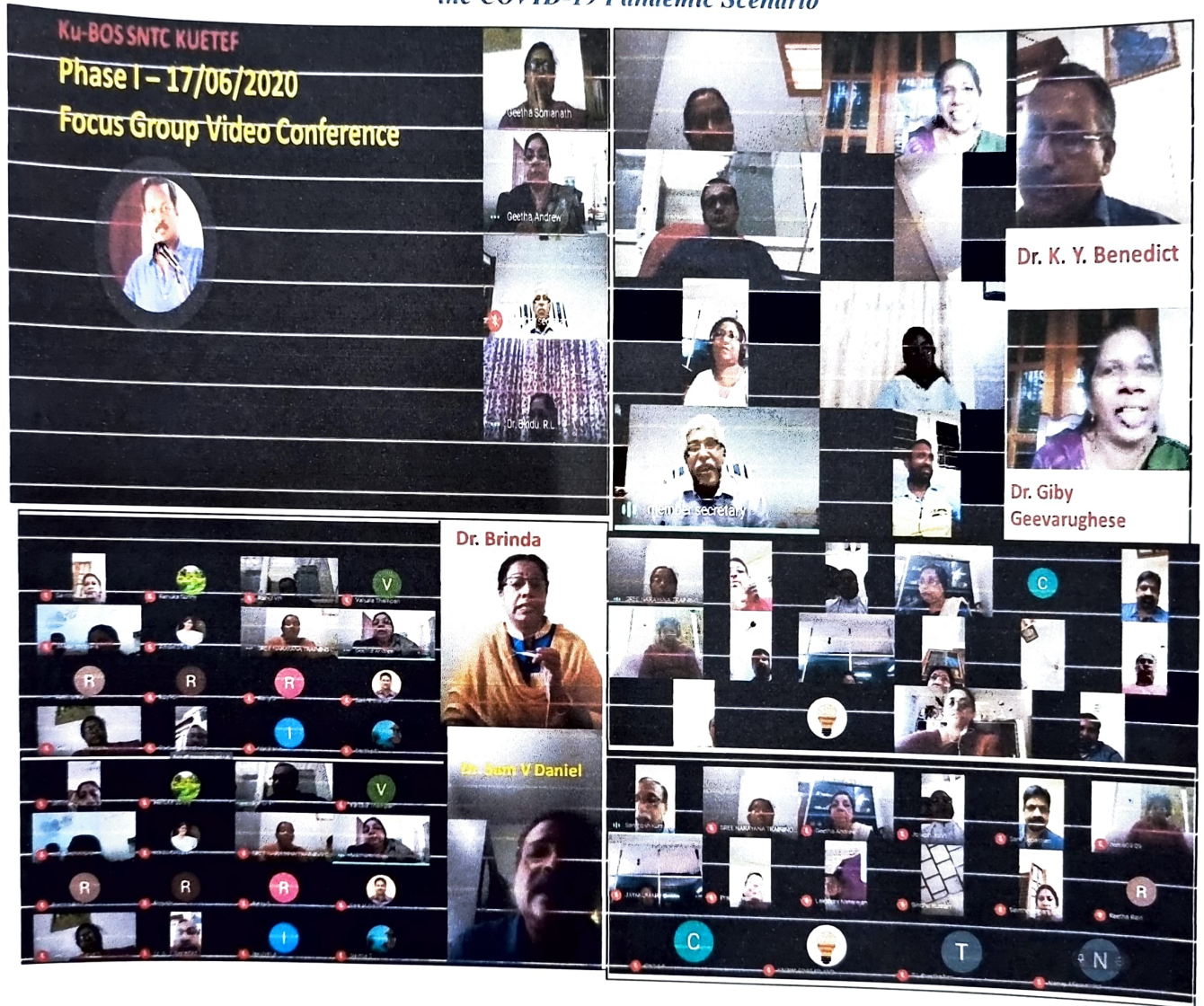

Education at all levels can shape the world of tomorrow, equipping individuals and societies with the perspectives, knowledge, skills, attitudes and values to live and work in a sustainable manner. The higher education system in India has developed in a noteworthy way, particularly in the post-Independence period, to become one of the prime systems of its kind in the world. It has been used as a reliable tool to build a knowledge-based information society. The main aim of Higher Education is to contribute to the development and improvement of society as a whole in a sustainable manner. It also aims at meeting the needs of all sectors of human activity. The overriding public interest of the present century is to promote accountability for moving to world-class quality and performance. In order to survive in the competitive world of globalization, all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) should pay special attention to quality. Govt. of India has taken a number of steps to enhance the quality of Indian Higher Education through different agencies like NAAC, QCI, NBA and State Level Accreditation Agency like SAAC.

**MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS BY UGC**

The UGC in its recent meeting has approved the objectives set for improving the quality of HEIs. To improve the quality of graduates and provide employment opportunities to them the HEIs have been asked to improve the graduate outcomes, so that at least 50% of them could secure access to employment/ self-employment or engage themselves in pursuit of Higher Education. HEIs have also been asked to get themselves accredited by NAAC with a minimum score of 2.5 by 2022. It also mandates for mentoring of non-accredited institutions, so that every institution can get accreditation by 2022.

**SAAC TO INITIATIVE ACCREDITATION**

State Accreditation and Assessment Council, similar to NAAC, has been in the pipeline for over four years now. The idea was initiated with an objective to fasten the process of college assessment by providing an option to NAAC, which is generally burdened with colleges across the nation. With the formation of the State Council of Higher Education, the impending establishment of SAAC is gaining speed. In the new perspective plan for the state's higher education, the quality of institutions is highly significant for getting continued approval. Therefore, the government plans to increase the SAAC's domain from being an accreditation council to that of a directory for colleges.

Accreditation of Teacher Education Institutions needs some sort of clarification. "WHETHER IT IS QUALITY COUNCIL OF INDIA (QCI) OR NAAC", - the confusion still persists. Advise from National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) reflects that whichever be the agency, HEIs, including Teacher Education Institutions should maintain the quality parameters.

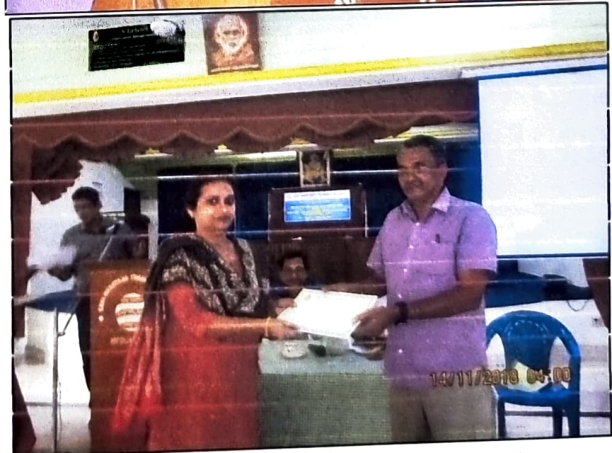
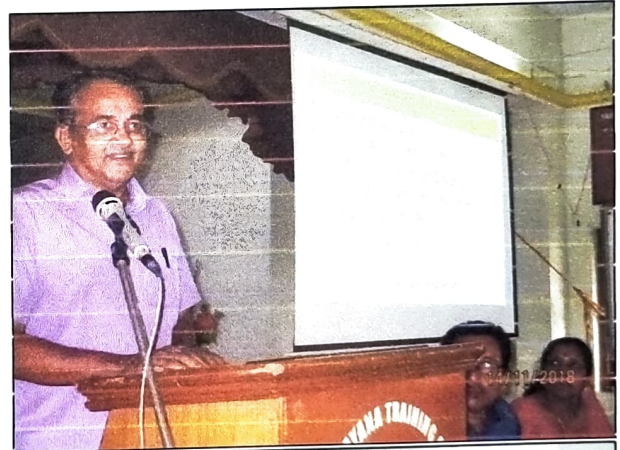

#### **2. Curriculum and Course Orientation to Semester I students**

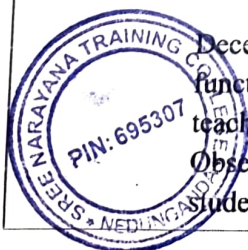

facilities in the school, observing the social climate in the school, etc. were the activities undertaken by the students during this

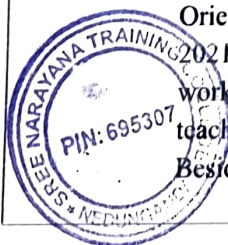
period. Each student-teacher engaged 3 lessons individually or as Shared Practice. A briefing of the activities conducted as part of School Induction programme is given below:

**PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO THE B.Ed. DEGREE COURSE 2021-'23**

**(TWO-YEAR PROGRAMME AS PER NCTE REGULATIONS 2014)**

**1. INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 Prospectus for admission to the B.Ed. Degree Course in Govt./ Aided/ Self--Financing Training Colleges and the Kerala University Colleges of Teacher Education (KUCTE) under the University of Kerala for the academic year 2021-'23 as approved by the University is published herewith. It contains general information and rules relating to the admission to the B.Ed. Course 2021-'23.
- 1.2 The prospectus issued during the previous years is not valid for the year 2021-'23.
- 1.3 Admissions shall be made by the respective colleges on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

**2. ACADEMIC (General)**

- 2.1 Candidates should have passed the B.A./ B.Sc. Degree Examination under the 10+2+3 pattern from the University of Kerala or any other University recognised by the University of Kerala.
- 2.2 Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from universities other than the University of Kerala should submit Eligibility/ Equivalency Certificate stating that their qualifying examination is recognised by the University of Kerala for seeking admission to B.Ed. Degree Course in a particular optional subject in a stream as applicable, along with their application.
- 2.3 Double or Triple main candidates or candidates who have passed the Degree Examination in Vocational or Specialised Courses are also eligible for admission. However, they have to submit copy of their Eligibility/ Equivalency Certificate from the University of Kerala stating that their qualifying examination is recognised by the Universities for seeking admission to B.Ed. Degree Course in a particular optional subject in a stream as applicable, along with their application.
- 2.4 The minimum requirement of marks for admission to B.Ed. Degree Courses is 50% for Part III/ 50% in aggregate (Parts I+II+III together) in Bachelors' Degree (Science/ Arts Subjects) or 50% marks in post-graduation in the concerned subject.
- 2.5 Ranking of candidates shall be on the basis of marks obtained for Part III.
- 2.6 No rounding off the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is permitted.

**Academic Eligibility should be satisfied as on the last date for submission of application.**

**3. RELAXATION IN MARKS**

- 3.1 Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes (SC/ ST) communities with pass, for Graduation and Post-Graduation in the respective optional subjects, are eligible for admission.
- 3.2 Candidates belonging to the Socially and Educationally Backward Communities (SEBC) will be given 5% concession
- 3.3 Candidates belonging to the Other Eligible Communities (OEC) will be give 5% concession.
- 3.4 Blind candidates will be given 5% concession. (G.O(Rt) No. 301/10/H.Edn dated 10-02-2010).
- 3.5 Candidates should be physically fit and mentally sound.
- 3.6 **Age: There is no upper age limit for admission to B.Ed. course**

**4. CHOICE OF OPTIONAL SUBJECTS**

- 4.1 The optional subject for the B.Ed. course should be the same as one, which the student has selected as main subject for graduation, or the main subject for graduation conventionally recognized to be coming under the optional chosen. **In case, the main subject is different from or conventionally considered as not coming under the optional opted for admission, a**



copy of the Certificate from the University of Kerala, stating that such degree is eligible for admission to that optional for B.Ed. course, should be furnished along with the application.

4.2 **Eligibility for Different optional Subjects:** Candidates seeking admission to the B.Ed. course in a subject/stream will have to satisfy the academic eligibility applicable to the subject/stream.

## 5. HOW TO APPLY

Candidates who seek admission for B.Ed. course should submit their applications in the college of their option as per schedule of admission published by the University. Candidates can purchase the application forms from the colleges where they would like to join. The applications filled in all respects supported by necessary documents have to be submitted to the college before the last date of submission of application. Admission will be done by the individual colleges on the basis of the Rank list published. Complaints if any, regarding ranking he to be brought to the attention of the principals concerned for rectification within three days from the date of publication of rank list. Late complaints will not be entertained. The colleges will upload the rank list in their websites.

## 6. CERTIFICATES/ DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH THE FILLED IN APPLICATION

- 6.1 Self--attested photocopy of SSLC or any relevant school records to prove date of birth.
- 6.2 Self-attested photocopies of the mark lists of all parts of the qualifying examination(s) and Degree/ Provisional Certificate.
- 6.3 Certificate to prove nativity.
- 6.4 Certificates in support of claim for Communal Reservation, if applicable.
- 6.5 Self-attested photocopies of certificates in support of Special Reservation, if applicable.
- 6.6 Copy of the Equivalency Certificate and Eligibility Certificate from the University of Kerala, stating that their qualifying examination is recognised for seeking admission to B.Ed. Degree Course in a particular optional subject/ in a stream as applicable, in case of double or triple main candidates/ or candidates who have passed the Degree Examination in Vocational or Specialised Courses.
- 6.7 Self--attested photocopy of NSS/ NCC certificate at the Degree level, if applicable.
- 6.8 Any other documents mentioned in the notification or those called for later.

## 7. WEIGHTAGE/ DEDUCTION

- 7.1 15 marks will be given to candidates who have First Class PG Degree, 10 marks for Second Class PG Degree, 5 marks for Third Class PG Degree in the same subject for which the candidate seeks admission. Weightage for PG marks will be given to candidates only where minimum qualification is graduation.
- 7.2 10 marks each for certificate holders of National Service Scheme (NSS)/ National Cadet Corps (NCC) for participation in NSS/ NCC at the Degree level. Weightage marks will be added to the marks obtained in Part III of the qualifying examination.
