1. Student empowerment programme SEP

The context

The SEP intended to enhance the capabilities of the future teachers through all round development. The activities designed during the year included research talks on various topics and job fair as part of career orientation. Both the programmes were felt as they need of the hour. Moreover professional competence enhancement is essential aspect in today's competitive world. Hence the College initiated those programmes.

I. Resource talks

The energy club of Sree Narayana training college has organised the resource talks on nanotechnology and green chemistry. Both the talks intended to develop optimum utilisation of resources in our environment and the key speakers led the session with an array of life related learning experience is and interaction. As part of the art education the famous magician Sri Harish Taha from Attingal has presented a show which provided a new learning experience for the student teachers.

In collaboration with the community living camp a resource talk was organised for the student teachers on the topic *Need For First Aid In General Life*. It provided awareness on first aid that every individual should know for the enhancement of their personal and professional life. Prof. R.S. Balakrishna former principal of M.M. Teacher Training College provided and interactive as well as demonstration session for the students.

In order to enhance the legal awareness among student teachers a session was organised by Mr Amjith S. from department of physical education. Mr. Sofi Mohan M.R., associate professor from government law college, Trivandrum delivered a resource talk on the topic *Legal Aspects Related To Students*. The topic provided an indepth explanation about students status in various aspects of legal consciousness. The class provided an interactive session for the question-answer phase in which majority of the students participated actively.

As part of the gender sensitization programme, the women study unit of Sree Narayana Training College organised an invited talk on the topic issues existing in colleges related to gender. Dr. Seema Jerome, Associate Professor, Department of Malayalam from the University of Kerala delivered an interactive session on the topic.

To enhance that achievement in competitive examination with special reference to Teacher eligibility test such as K-TET, C-TET and SET a resource class was organised by the career guidance club of the college. The session provided resource talk as well as sample materials for the preparation of various competitive examinations related .

II. Job fest 2018- Campus Placement Programme

During the year, the guidance club of the college organised *Job Fest 2018* on 23/03/ 2018 as part of the campus placement programme. The programme was inaugurated by Sri. Aji S.R.M., S.N. Trust executive member Kollam. Outgoing students as well as former students attended the programme. Various reputed schools from Kollam and Trivandrum districts had joined the programme to recruit meritorious students from the college.

During the academic year all the programmes organised to empower the student potentialities were successful and is evidence in the outcome derived.

Evidence of success

Majority of the SEP organised by the college helped to instil the spirit of organisational capacity among future teachers. It was evident during their practice teaching phases. The student teachers had organised a number of extra-curricular programmes including practical session in the schools. The spark for organising various events outside the college was initiated through the multifocused Student Empowerment Programmes in the college. The enhancement of results in various teacher eligibility test is another evidence of success of the teacher orientation programme. During the job first nearly 40% of the students were shortlisted by various schools from Trivandrum and Kollam district.

2. Snehapoorvam

In order to develop social consciousness and service mentality among the prospective teachers, the college organises a charity service named *Snehapoorvam* (with love) for the people in the locality.

Observation of Sankar's day

On 7th November 2017 under the guidance of Sree Narayana study centre the college observed Sankar's day, the commemoration day of R. Sankar, the Founder Manager and former Chief Minister of Kerala. On Sankar's day, the faculty of the college took initiative in distributing rice

for the economically backward people in the locality. The students also become the part of the social service organised by the college.

Apart from the Sankar's Day observation and service to the community, the college took initiative in plantation of saplings to the locality on the World environment day, beach cleaning and removal of plastic waste from the papanasam beach and thereby rendered a helping hand to clean the surroundings. The student teachers of various subject had prepared and distributed low-cost learning aids for the nearby secondary school students as an extension service is also as a social service activity organised as part of this *Snehapoorvam* project. The project is planning to improvise more socially useful services in the forth-coming years under guidance of various clubs and associations of the college. Thus, the Snehapoorvam is trying to expand its responsibilities by considering the immediate needs of the community.

Evidence of success

Every activity organised as part of snehapooram intends to develop social and human values which are the basic essential values to be developed among every human being. The efforts made by the students in participating those activities and organising similar activities in the practice teaching schools during the teaching practice phases are the evidence for the successful achievement of the same.

Problems encountered and the resources required

The rigid academic works including theoretical and practical sessions were found to be major hindrances in the organisation of any activity in the teacher education system. Hence majority of the activities were organised in connection with and in collaboration with subject association, clubs and college union of the institution. So, the time factor was seemed to be the utmost resource required for conducting any activity in the college.

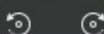
